Report

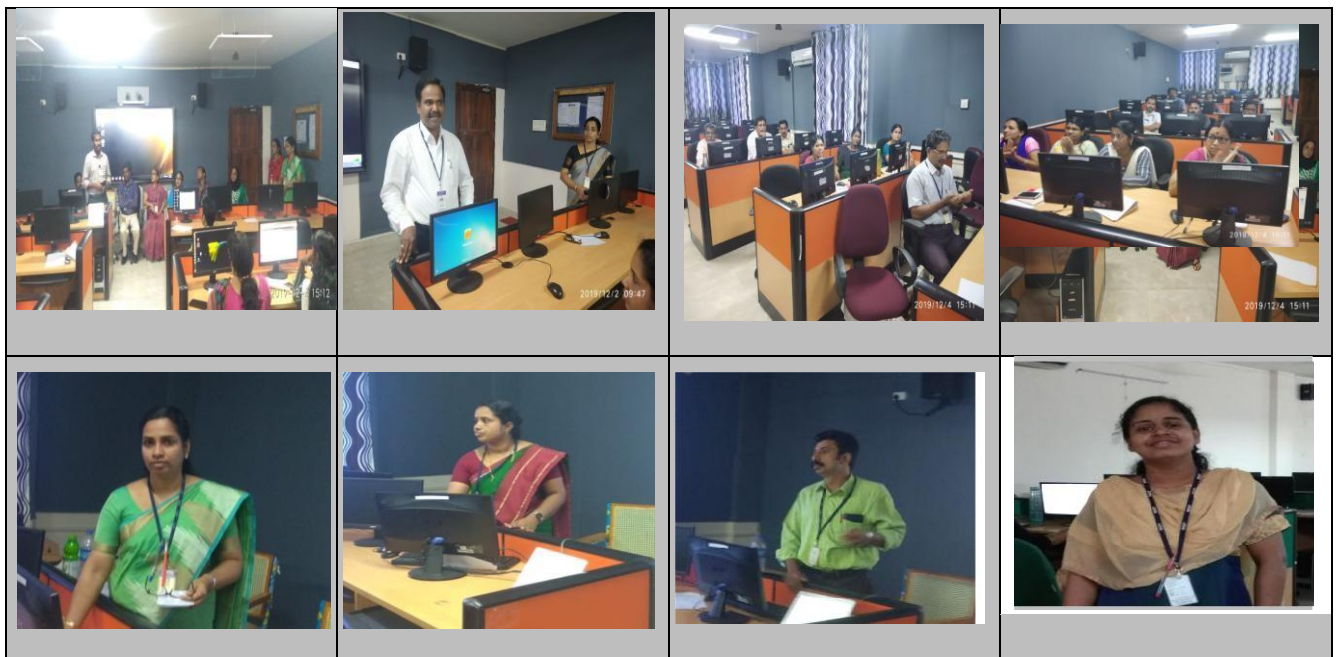
Department of Computer Science & Engineering (CSE), in association with R-SAIL conducted a three day faculty development program (FDP) on “**Interdisciplinary Software And Hardware Tools**”, during 2nd to 4th December 2019. The Technical Staffs from all departments were participated in the program. The main aim was to empower our technical staffs with computer skills.

Day-1 (02/12/2019):

The morning session was started with the basics of programming using the high level language ‘C’. And we made all staffs to code a simple C program having simple input output functions and simple arithmetic operations. And they learnt how to edit, compile and run a C program.

In the Afternoon session we started with Microsoft office word 2007 software. We explained the document preparation and Menu options in word.



Day-2 (03/12/2019):

The morning session on day-2 was concentrated on more features on MS Word. The afternoon session was started with MS Excel and learned how to make work sheets and explained all features of Ms Excel. Then started with MS Powerpoint which enabled them to make presentation using slideshows. Also learned how to make Google Forms for getting feedback.
